



Literacy Test (OSSLT) Preparation Site - LMS Online Access Information



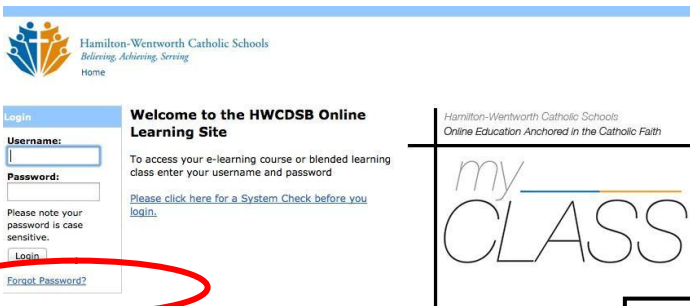
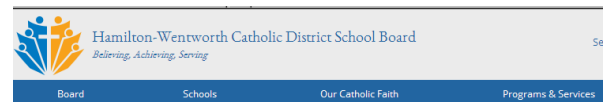
